






Comfort the Children takes pride in a holistic approach to community development. CTC initiatives focus on five areas, all interrelated: education, environment, economy, health and community. Each area directly impacts the community as a whole and each is connected to the success of the others.

CTC Land -11.5 acres off of the main road through Maai Mahiu known as "the HIV Highway." We have successfully connected to a sustainable water source, are growing a large-scale demonstration garden, nature trail, livestock co-op, poultry project.

Gardens in schools- Demonstration gardens, tree nursery, and environmental clubs for youth that teach sustainable farming methods and promote environmental awareness.

Social enterprise- farm-to-table café, products handmade by women to support the education of special needs children.
